VISUAL ARTIST, SCULPTOR

- Mojtaba Ramzi is an Iranian sculptor, who was born in 1973, in Tehran.
- He started his artistic career in graphic design and continued in Painting and Animation directing in university. He's been working as sculptor for more than two decades and worked as an academic mentor for more than ten years.
- The basic themes of his artworks are life, liberty, destiny, fate and gambling which he is trying to represent them throughout the Sphinxes. In this narrating, he uses the visual traditions of prehistorical and ancient era of Iranian art and also Mesopotamian art.
- His intention is to be able to get connected with other nation's audiences although his representation of local motifs and legends in his works in the meanwhile.
- Ramzi has presented his artworks on six different solo exhibitions in Tehran, Paris and Beirut.
- He has also participated in several events including art fairs, art residencies, biennials and auctions in Tehran, Paris, London, Toronto, Budapest, Transylvania, Seoul, Beirut, Dubai and Abu Dhabi.
